028/18 Apologies for absence; were received from Cllr. Daly who is on holiday,

029/18 Declarations of interest; there were none.

030/18 Public participation; Mr A. Pearson representing the PFFA, updated the Council on the progress of the new pre school building on the playing field, it was agreed when he has further information as to costs etc he would update the Council.
