Things to consider for the Audit

1. A walk out of the village is non-existent and can not be pleasant, so the audit can help address this
2. There was a discussion on the path at Goonreeve farm as this is a dangerous exit onto the A39. Considerations could be to divert this path. The audit will help this.
3. The group discussed Enys Gardens and agreed it has good protection and is an example of good practice within the Parish.
4. The path around Malthouse close, is this recorded as a right of way?
5. Quality of paths would include signage, multiuse etc.
